

Completion of Competition Sheets

Entering

Competition sheets will normally go up at the end of the previous competition.

Members wishing to fish in the Club boats must write their names in the left hand column of the sheet.

Members intending to fish from a private boat must not write their names on the main sheet as this might deprive someone else a place. There are separate registration slips for private boats. Private boat owners should obtain a supply from Iain Rose

Members wishing to bring guests must complete the first three columns of the bottom section of the sheet. Do not enter guests names in the main list.

Guests may only fish if there are spaces left after all members are accommodated.

The person collecting the petrol and pools money will tick the paid column for each person who has paid

Do not write anywhere else

Recording results

Weighing in must not start until all boats and equipment are cleaned and put away.

The person recording the results must enter the number of fish, the total weight, the species and weight of all notable fish and the number of the target species caught by each angler.

Do not write in any of the 'Points' columns.

Each angler is accountable for ensuring that their catch is properly weighed and recorded.

Completed sheets are to be returned to Iain Rose.

All queries concerning results must be made to Iain within four weeks of the competition concerned.
